

## ROBOT MAKE-UP TUTORIAL



### ABOUT THE ARTIST:

**Notice:** As always, make sure your artist is aware of materials you will be putting on their skin. Make use of allergy safety checks, and keep some soap and warm water on hand for cleanup.



### STEP 1: LINES

1. Map out lines, for this look we used an eyeliner pencil.

### STEP 2: GREEN BASE

1. Fill in areas around the face with Kryolan UV Aquacolor Green. Namely the cheeks, temples, and chin. Layer for solid color.



### STEP 3: DON'T SHORT CIRCUIT!

1. Next, create a circuit-tech pattern across your green surfaces. We recommend Graftobian pro paint black swan. Google search for some android like motherboard patterns for reference. If you have your Plague Crate, this is a perfect opportunity to use your brushes.

## STEP 4: ALL THAT GLITTERS IS GOLD

1. Now mix your metal mania kit and fill in all bare skin spaces with gold. We recommend around or on the face, neck, and lower chest.



## STEP 5: CONTRAST

1. For contrast and added embellishment, you can paint your front face a flat complimentary color. Our artist chose white, which makes for a nice "face plate" effect.

## STEP 6: GET FLASHY

1. You can use your Fantasy Eyes green flash over the raised edges of your face. Lightly brush over the brow to bridge and tip of your nose. Also be sure to shade the edges of your face. You can apply 2 layers of this if needed.



## STEP 7: FINAL TOUCHES

1. Finish by painting your lips and lower eyelids with Kryolan Aquacolor and brushing some gold into your eyebrows.
