

PLAGUE MAKE-UP TUTORIAL



FROM THE ARTIST:

The idea for this month is that we will create a disease, a sickness. Make sure the subject is clean faced and not allergic to latex. When you are working with a model and don't know if they are sensitive, try it on their wrist.

Warning: People allergic to latex should not use the latex contained in this kit!

STEP 1: PICK A SPOT! ANY SPOT!

1. Lay a layer of liquid latex on the skin, or site of infection.
2. Take a cotton ball and stretch it out. Apply the cotton onto the latex field.
3. Apply another layer of latex onto the cotton, especially on the edges, via q-tip.



STEP 2: YOU'RE SO VEIN!



1. Next take some wisps of cotton and roll them into long strands. These will serve as pronounced veins.
2. Lay veins onto the latex site and extend as far across the skin as desired, you can even place them onto the neck.

OPTIONAL: If you choose to spread the latex thin enough, you can do some cool stuff with it, such as added textures

STEP 3: ADDING SOME PUSTULES

1. You can ball some cotton into tiny lumps, and press them onto the latex to create bulbs or pustules.
