

UNDEAD MAKE-UP TUTORIAL

Remember to clean your face thoroughly and make sure that whomever you are using these products on are not allergic or sensitive to these products. Also do not ingest, swallow, or put any of this product into your mouth or eyes!

STEP 1: STICK IT ON!

1. The 3D transfers have an excellent step-by-step guide right on the box. Follow that and the video to get the most out of these prosthetics.

Tip: If you have it, take some rubbing alcohol and brush over the wounds to soften the prosthetics, and remove any excess edges.



STEP 2: COLOR

1. Apply Kryolan Supracolor foundation by dabbing onto face/skin; this will create a nice dead complexion.

2. Be sure to take all the red colors out of the face or skin site.

Tip: Use a wedge sponge and dab the product onto the face. Be thorough and get right into hairline.

STEP 3: EDGES

1. Now take black creme to create depth around the transfers and your models eyes.

2. Blend onto temples to contrast and make front facial surfaces pop.
Tip: In last month's crate you can use the purple and red to show bruising and more dynamic rot. Use the sponge to dab around the applicants and make it look nasty!

Optional: If you feel you have gone too far, use the foundation to go over it. Dry brushing the transfers with foundation will create even more depth.
